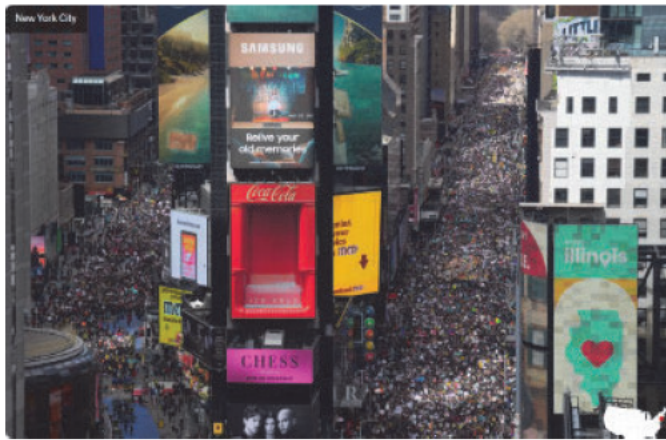

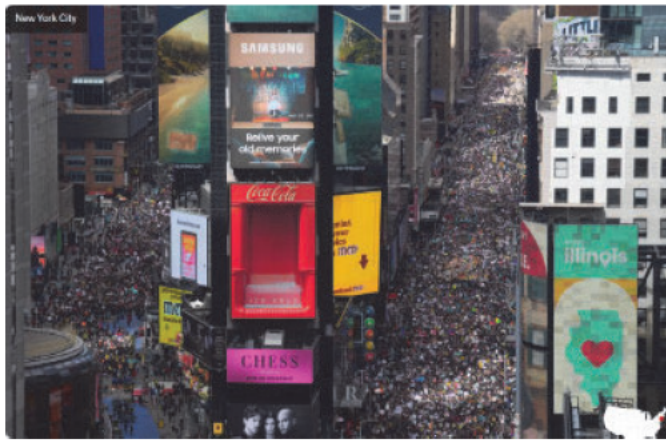

I'm reaching out for a story I'm writing about an activist group that is opposing Sheba Medical Center's presence in Massachusetts and its partnership with the state. The group, ShebaOutOfMA, most recently held a protest outside of the ARC headquarters, and they did some standouts before the turn of the year at the State House, including a "die-in". They also have a [3,000+ signature petition](#) into Gov. Healey.

Their motives align with usual divestment arguments — that Mass. shouldn't be spending tax dollars or state resources on an Israeli institution, or welcoming an institution "complicit in genocide," in their own words. I'm looking for a statement from your office in response to the opposition. In addition, I have two specific questions I'm hoping you can answer:

1. It is my understanding, based on public records requests, that the Healey administration had at least two staff members take a trip to Sheba in Israel in December. Can you describe the purpose of the trip and how it was paid for?
2. It is also my understanding, based on public records requests, that the Mass Life Sciences Center in March 2025 encouraged Sheba ARC to apply for tax incentives of up to \$5 million, as well as other state-funded programs. Are you able to comment on this in the context of the state's financial relationship with Sheba? And is this typically done when a major new company moves to Boston/the state?
